HORTICULTURAL

Flowers should be displayed in a clean container of appropriate size. The flowers not the container are judged.

1. Daffodil 3 stems, single trumpet, single variety
2. Daffodil 1 stem, single trumpet
3. Daffodil 3 stems, single cup, single variety
4. Daffodil 1 stem, single cup
5. Daffodil 3 stems, double or split corona, single variety
6. Miniature daffodils 3 stems, single variety
7. Multi-headed daffodils 3 stems, single variety
8. Daffodils 3 stems, 3 varieties
9. Mixed vase of Daffodils
10. Hellebores, dish of floating flowers (max 10 blooms)
11. Grape Hyacinths 5 stems, no foliage
12. Tulips 3 stems
13. Any other spring bulbs 3 stems in water
14. Polyanthus, Primula or Primrose 3 stems, no foliage
15. Pansies and/or Violas 5 stems, no foliage
16. Flowering shrub or tree, 3 stems, 3 varieties in water
17. Flowering shrub or tree, 1 stem in water
18. Hyacinth, 1 flower head
19. Flowering Heathers, 3 stems in water
20. Vase of mixed spring flowers, foliage & stems
21. Any other spring flower, 3 stems in water
22. Flowering pot plant, or house plant
23. Foliage pot plant or House plant
24. Selection of 3 Culinary Herbs
25. Rhubarb 5 sticks,
26. Any winder of over wintered vegetable
27. Weird and wonderful, anything with unusual growth, twisted, contorted, out of season, leaf, stem or flower
28. Most fragrant flower, not hyacinth, 1 stem
29. Spring outdoor container (to include plants and bulbs)

N.B. Trumpet or Cup Daffodil? If the trumpet or cup is deeper or longer than the length of the petal, then the daffodil is a trumpet. If it is the same length or shorter than the petal, it is a cup.

A split corona has no trumpet or cup but looks as though the trumpet or cup has been split and opened out so it forms a second row of petals.

EGGS

31. Three dark brown hen eggs on a plate
32. Three white or cream hen eggs on a plate
33. Three duck eggs on a plate
34. Six Bantam eggs on a plate
35. Three any other eggs on a plate (not to include any hen eggs)

DOMESTIC

36. A jar of Jam or preserve
37. A jar of Marmalade
38. A hard boiled egg.
39. Six Cheese Straws
40. Six slices of Shortbread
41. Six slices of your favourite tray bake
42. White Bread Loaf. Your favourite recipe.
43. A Victoria Sandwich.
44. Fruit cake, 8 inch approx. Your favourite recipe.
45. A Chocolate cake 8 inch approx.
46. Bake your favourite cake (any other cake not listed above)
